At Obstacool, we are passionate about getting more and more kids active and away from gadgets. Sure, these to have a place in our children's lives for educational purposes but they also have a time they should be used and that isn't all day.

We take Obstacool all over the country with the primary focus of getting kids active, having a stack of fun and meeting new friends along the way!

The Course

Designed with fun and safety in mind, the Obstacool course includes a range of obstacles that are both challenging and fun. Suitable for kids of all fitness levels, the course has been designed to allow participants to run at their own pace. A mix of giant inflatables, tunnel crawls, small wall climbs, tyre runs among many other obstacles, the course is guaranteed to have all participants smiling from ear to ear!

Supervision

We have qualified staff running the course, but we require teacher supervision at each obstacle to ensure the kids are staying safe. With the amount of numbers running through the course, it is very challenging for our team members to keep an eye on everyone all the time. Parents are welcome to watch from viewing areas during their kids run.

Safety

A genuine focus on safety is of utmost importance. We take safety seriously and we are focused on always providing a safe environment with qualified staff and volunteers, who all undergo strict working with children and police checks. We pride ourselves on our commitment to safety. Each Obstacool participant is identified via a unique ID that is matched to the parent or guardian who signs their waiver and checks them in at registration.

What to Wear

Participants will be running around and getting down and dirty, so we advise all kids to wear suitable shoes for running and comfortable clothes that won't get them in trouble with mum or dad if they come home covered in dirt, sweat and tears... tears of laughter that is!





Merchandise

Obstacool T-shirts, hats, drink bottles and other cool branded merchandise for kids are available to purchase online prior to or after the event.



How will the day run?

To avoid the little kids getting nervous about running with the bigger kids, we segregate the day into groups by school years. The minimum age for Obstacool at open events is 5 years old but given the kindergarten kids will be running together, 4 years old is acceptable.

- Kindergarten 9:30 10:00 am
- Year 1/2 10:30 11:00 am
- Year 3/4 11:30 12:00 noon
- Year 5/6 12:30 1:00 pm

This is just a guide as some school may have a large amount of children in a particular year making it hard to run them all in the same wave. In this case, that year will run split times.

Given there are a number of obstacles on the course such as tyres, tunnels, wall wedges and slides, we traditionally have a volunteer at each obstacle to help the kids over if they're having any trouble but primarily to ensure they're staying safe. Ideally, if we come to your school, we'd like a teacher or other staff member to man each obstacle to ensure the kids running stay safe.

Investment

This covers our teams travel, set up, running the day and packing away at the end of the day as well as first aid (hopefully not required).

We transport the course in a 3 tonne truck so access to a grassed area or playground is paramount as the inflatable obstacles weigh a fair bit.
